

Day-1 (22 July 2019, Monday)

Session-1: 10.00 am to 11.00 am

Day-2 (23 July 2019, Tuesday)

Session-1: 09.30 am to 12.30 pm

An enlightening lecture on "Student empowerment" was delivered by Rev.Fr. Paul Potteckal. He talked about the Intelligence quotient, Emotional Quotient and Attitude Quotient which are highly important in understanding the life in depth to manage the equilibrium of life situations which will eventually facilitate a better understanding of individuals to lead happier & healthy life. He emphasized on Adolescent problem behavior, including substance use and college misconduct .



He also added that to grow into a successful professional, an individual needs to have good leadership qualities, excellent communication skills, stress bearing capacity, innovative ideas and self-confidence.

Session-2: 01.15 pm to 04.00 pm

The objective of this session was to provide a common platform to the students to have an open interaction with their faculty advisors. Students were divided into small groups, each assigned to a senior student as a student guide, and to a faculty member as a mentor. Faculty advisors gave their inputs and some tips to the mentees on how they can nurture their overall capabilities. The students also discussed some queries/incidents related to their ongoing regular classes.



Day-3 (24 July 2019, Wednesday)

Session-1: 09.30 am to 12.30 pm

Mr. Irfan, Student of S3 CSE, started the session with a briefing on "IEEE activities at SIMAT". He amazed viewers by his mind reading & stage hypnotism. Students and staffs were invited to play a leading role as Sravan predicts and influences their behavior.
