This letter is to bring to your kind attention, the incident that occurred on 14th February 15, 2017 in front of mechanical HOD's room at evening interval.

A group of S6 EEE students were manhandling S4 ME B student Mr. Md. Riyas V U in front of S4 ME classroom. Mr. Crecentine tried to intervene and calm the situation by requesting the students to disperse from the scene. The students didn't follow his orders, instead shouted at him. In the mean time Mr. Sarath S tried to interfere and resolve the matter. The students still showed their agitation towards the staff. The two students who were involved were called to ME HOD room for questioning.

The other group of EEE students protested this act and they refused to move from the entrance of HOD room even after repeated warnings from EEE HOD, ME HOD and several ME staff. They demanded the EEE student's release from HOD room.

We wish to point these incidents as an act of gross indiscipline growing among our students. The repetition of such incidents, may affect the morale of staff thereby abstaining them from enforcing the discipline in future.

This should not be neglected in any means and we kindly request you to take appropriate measures.

Enquiry Report of the incident happened on 14/02/2017

A group of S6 students of EEE department blocked and questioned a junior S4 ME student about 3 PM in front of the S4 ME classroom on 14th Feb 2017. Very soon the blocking and the delivery of arguments got into shouting and fighting between them. Timely intervention of the faculties of ME department and HOD of EEE diluted the situation to a certain extent. Based on the preliminary information collected from various sources the principal warned the students who were involved in the incident and an enquiry was ordered on the above incident

The sitting of the committee was held on 22nd Feb2017 and 27th Feb 2017 and heard from the students who are directly involved in the incident. Evidences were also collected from the faculties, who were there while the incident was taking place. The serious concern shared by the faculties is that some of the students especially from S6 EEE were reluctant to obey the order of the faculties.

The committee found that the senior students committed very serious offence as they had formed groups, unnecessarily crowded in front of the S4 ME classroom, shouted bad words and manhandled the junior students. The junior students have also committed mistakes as they had shouted and provoked the seniors.

Sarfas C, S6 EEE and Devadathan of S6 EEE were found guilty on the incident as they had shouted and manhandled Mohammed Riyas of S4 ME. Mohammed Riyas was also guilty as he had provoked his seniors by uttering bad words.

The Committee found that the incident was very serious and such a thing should not be repeated in the college at any cost. Since the above students involved in the incident understood the seriousness of the mistake they had done, and apologized for the same, the committee recommends a censure of warning to Sarfas C, Devadathan and Muhammed Riyas and try to understand them such a behavior is not conducive for the general discipline and peaceful atmosphere of the college.
