WOMEN CELL ANNUAL REPORT (2019-2020)

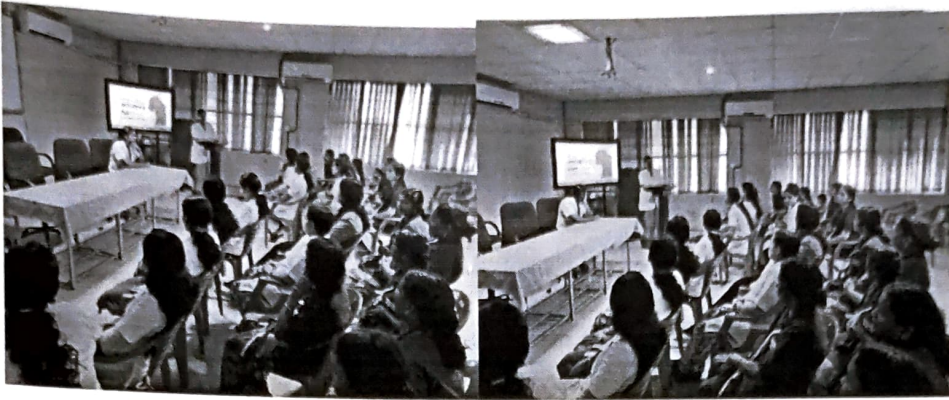

WOMEN CELL ANNUAL REPORT (2018-2019)

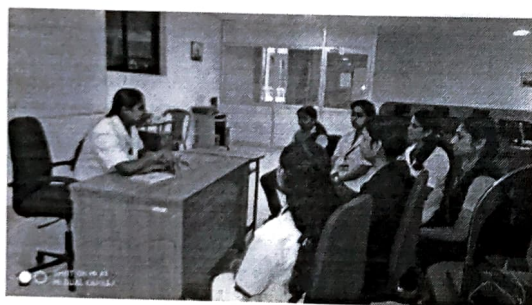

The first session was handled by Sri. Balakrishnan Pullat, he explained about the needs of Gender Equality, with the help of real time examples.

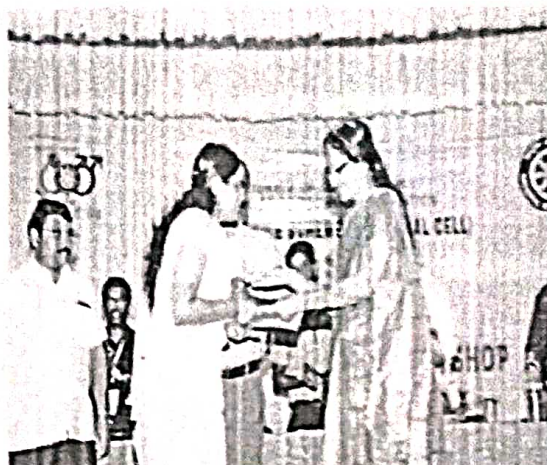


