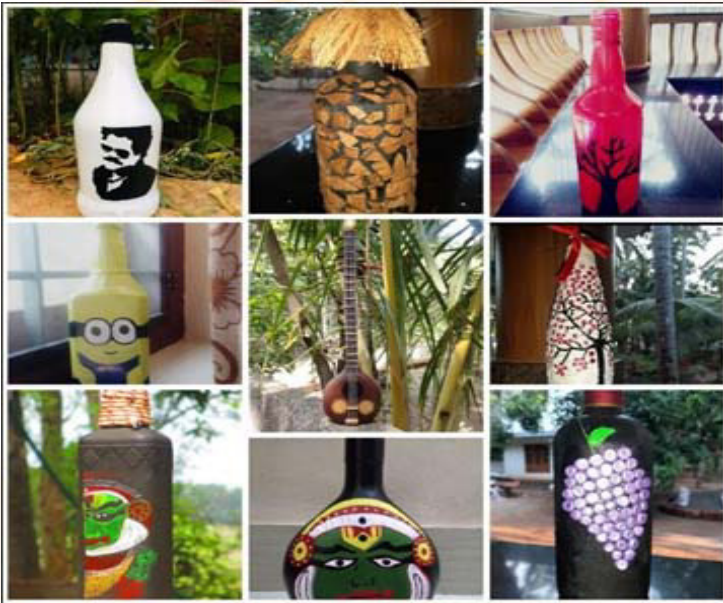
Srishti - Online Fest

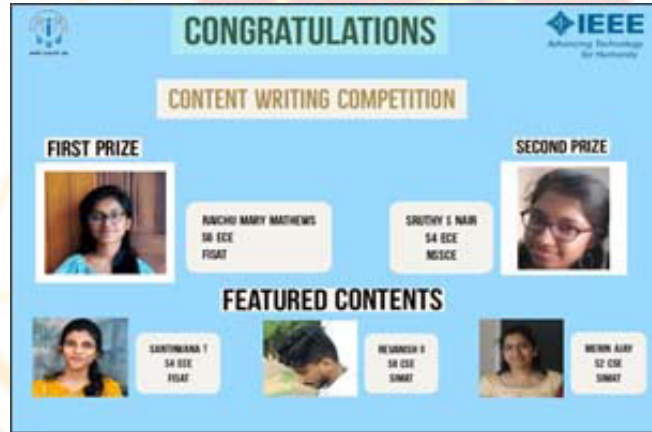
Even though in this technologically sufficient world, there are still many

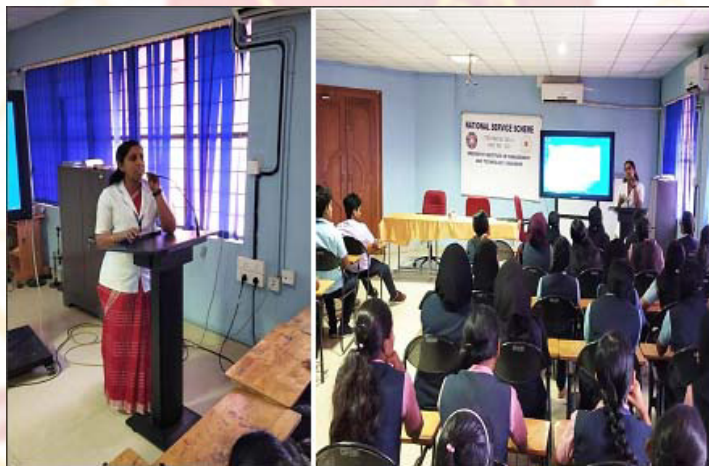
