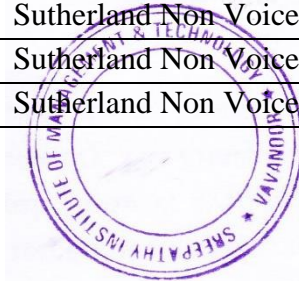

Induction Program

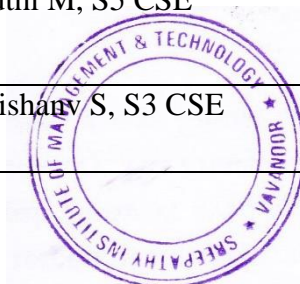

Co-curricular and extracurricular Activities

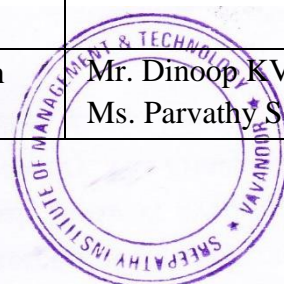

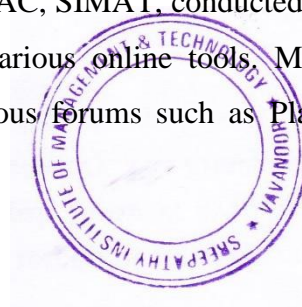

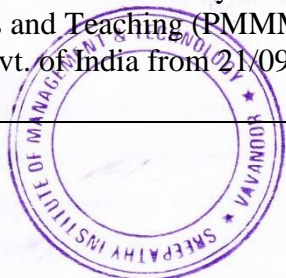
IEDC, ISTE, IEEE and NSS. Various departments also conducted the webinars related to their departments which was well attended by members across the state.

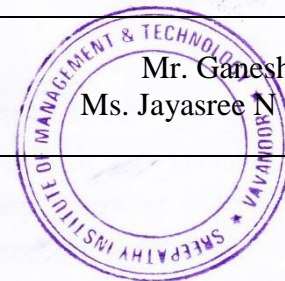

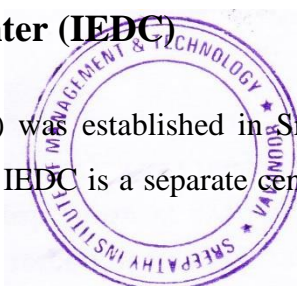

Innovation & Entrepreneurship Development Center (IEDC)

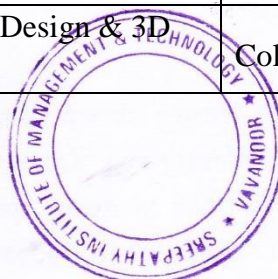
