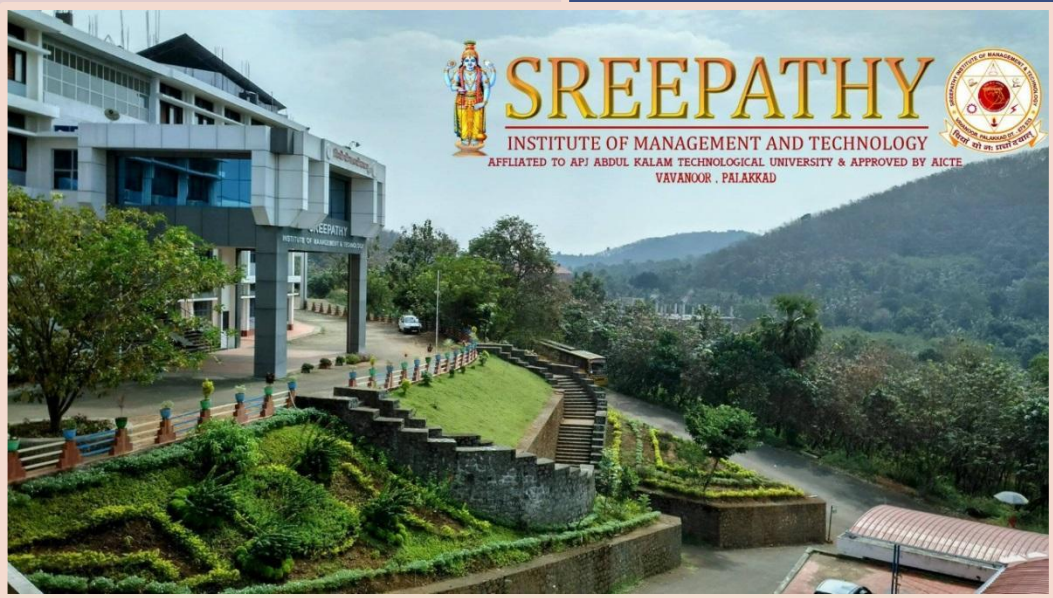

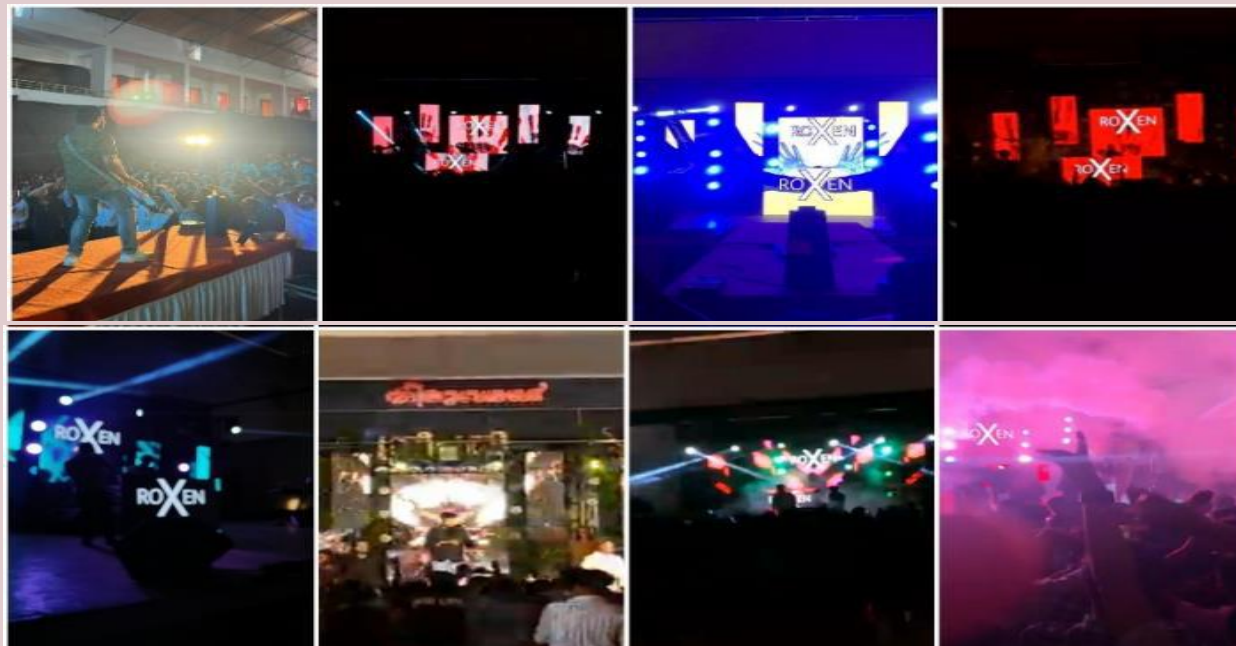
were given to them. It included stunning ramp walks, acting, dancing, quiz programs, variety of

## ENTREPRENEURSHIP- CUM- SKILL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM (E-SDP) IN CNC TURNING

Sreepathy Institute of Management and Technology, Vavanoor in association with the Ministry of Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises (MSME), DFO Thrissur organized and conducted an Entrepreneurship- cum- Skill Development Program (E-SDP) in CNC Turning at Sreepathy campus. It was a 30 days training program that started on 10<sup>th</sup> October 2022. The program was aimed at training candidates for skill development and to upgrade their professional skills for competing with the manufacturing future. Out of 50+ applications received, 25 candidates who met the minimum educational qualification (10th Pass + ITI / Diploma in Mechanical Engineering) were selected through interview. Candidates planning to start their own ventures were given more priority during the selection process. The program started with a formal Inauguration ceremony on 10<sup>th</sup> October 2022 in which the Program Coordinator, Smt. Athira Sadhu, Assistant Director- MSME DFO- Thrissur delivered the welcome speech. Dr. SP Subramanian, Principal- Sreepathy institute of Management and Technology delivered the inaugural address and formally inaugurated



the program. Mr. Prakash G S, Joint Director- MSME DFO- Thrissur virtually addressed the candidates. The inauguration ceremony followed by the registration processes were completed in the forenoon session and classes were started in the afternoon session. The Course syllabus was prepared and scheduled in such a way that the

candidates were able to understand the basics of manufacturing processes firstly and then going to the fundamentals of computerized turning processes in detail. Mr. Crecentine J K- AP/ME and Mr. Hari CN- Senior Lab Instructor / ME gave training in the conventional lathe operations. Mr. Sreedath M K AP/ME and Mr. Rejeesh PN- Lab Instructor/CE handled the sessions regarding CNC programming and simulation. Hands-on



training in CNC Lathe was given to the candidates under the supervision of Mr. Anil Kumar (Retd. CNC Trainer, HMT Kalamassery).

In addition to the Technical sessions, classes regarding Project submission, banking essentials etc. were also organized by MSME. A motivation class by Mr. Jayaprakash Balan, Corporate Trainer was also included in the course.



The 30 days training program ended on 21<sup>st</sup> November 2022 and the certificates were distributed in the valedictory ceremony which was held on 29<sup>th</sup> November 2022 in which Sri Jayan C Padmanabhan, Universal Agrico, Palakkad delivered the valedictory address and distributed the certificates to the candidates who successfully completed the course.

## RUDHIRAM BLOOD DONATION CAMP

The blood cell of NSS UNIT 233, SIMAT conducted a blood donation camp named “RUDHIRAM” on 18<sup>th</sup> November 2022 from 9.00 am to 1.00 pm at college auditorium. Registrations were done through Google

are identified to support the team.

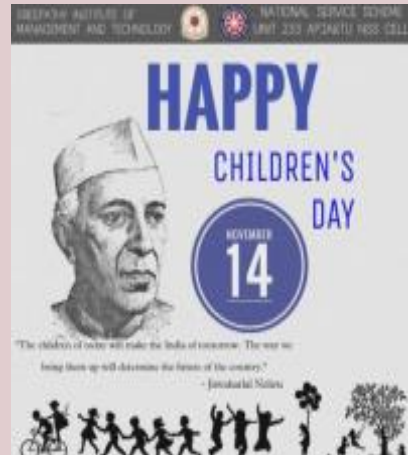
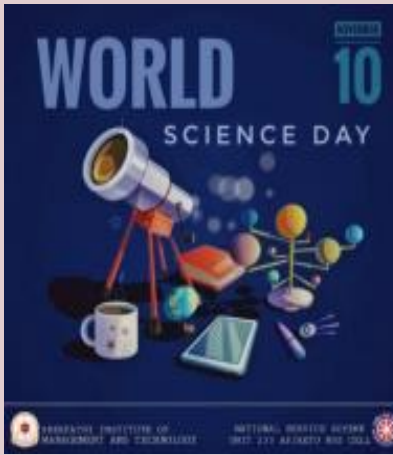
## STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT
