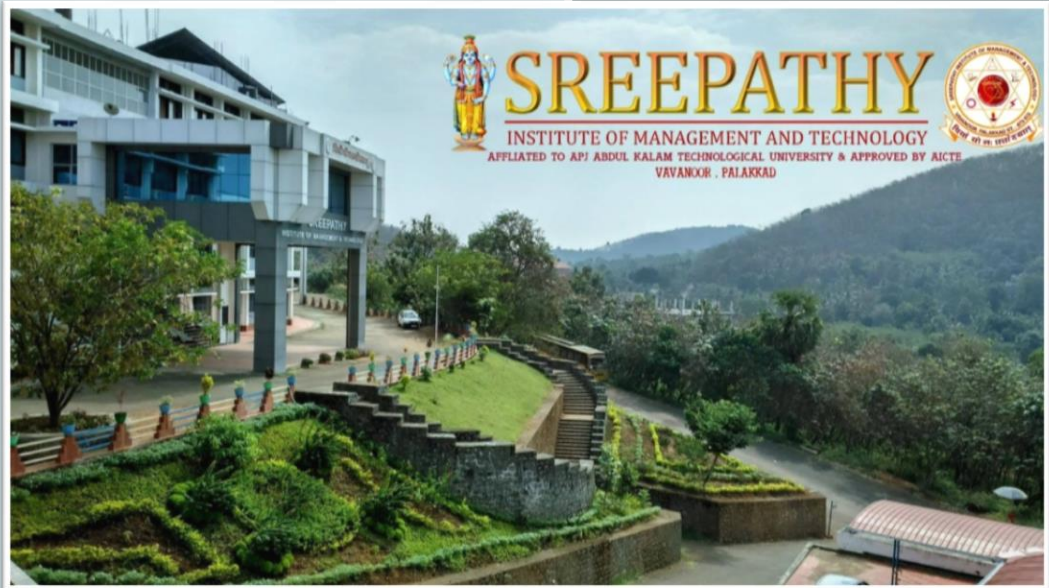

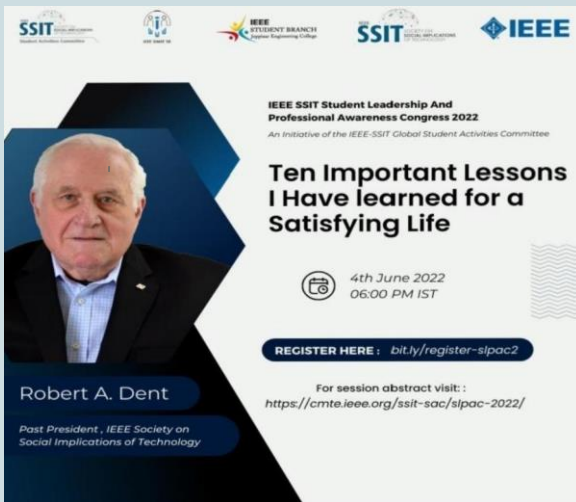


MAKING IEEE YOUR PROFESSIONAL HOME

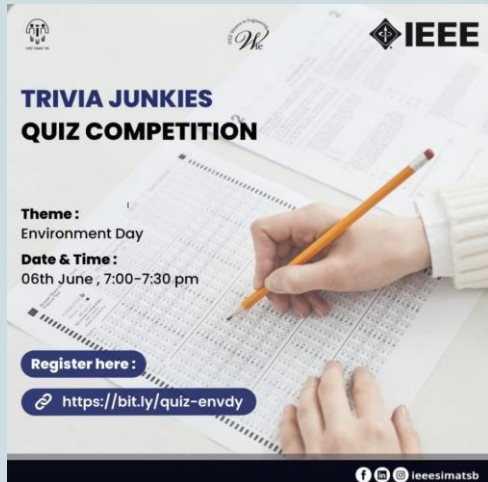


FLUTTER

ART BUZZ



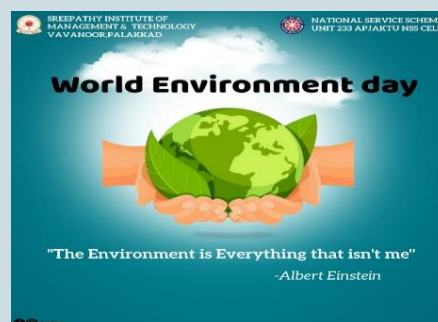

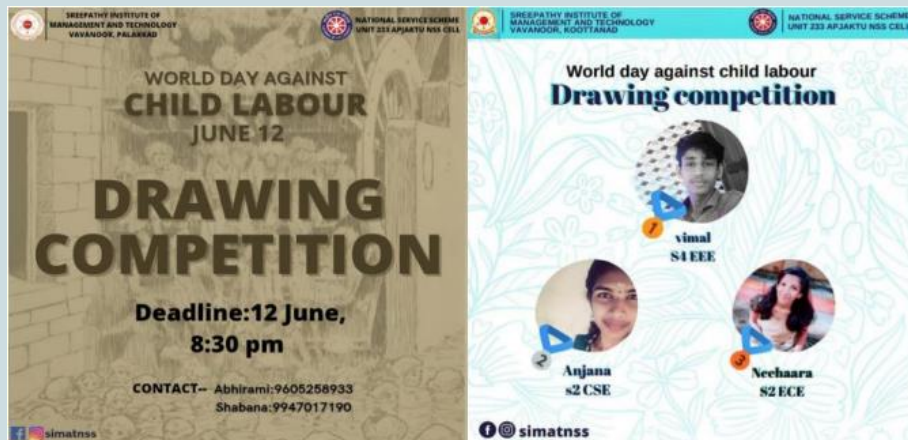
WORLD DAY AGAINST CHILD LABOUR

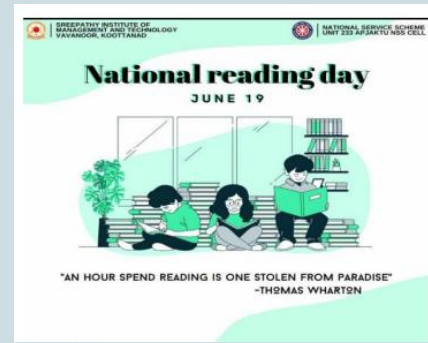
ANTI-CHILD LABOUR-DRAWING COMPETITION
