
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MONTHLY NEWS LETTER

YIP- SASTHRAPADHAM TRAIN THE TRAINER PROGRAM

Young Innovators Programme (YIP) is a specially designed programme under Kerala Development and Innovation Strategic Council (K-DISC) which aims to empower future innovators to innovate new products, services or models to meet emerging requirements, unarticulated needs, or existing market needs of the society more effectively through an innovative challenge. YIP has been successfully conducted at the college level since 2018. Now, Samgra Shikha Kerala (SSK), an overarching programme for the school education sector extending from pre-school to class 12. SSK has joined hands with K-DISC to implement the YIP at the school level. YIP 5.0 has been designed for school level and the implementation will be in three stages, viz., Block level, District level and State level. Each level will have 3 resource persons, of which

two will be from schools and the third one will be the IEDC Nodal Officer on behalf of K-DISC. The training programme for Palakkad district was held on 2023, January 18th and 19th at KPM Regency, Palakkad. This was a residential programme. The main goal of the programme was to inculcate the basic structure of YIP evaluation.

Day 1 (18/01/2023)

The inaugural session was informal and it lasted for 45 minutes from 11.00 am -11.45 am. District coordinator of YIP-



Sasthra Bandham, Mr. Thajudheen, inaugurated the programme. The need of such a programme in school level to encourage students innovative thinking by using the basic science for innovation was detailed by the speaker. The dias had Palakkad Block Resource Centre representatives, K-DISC Coordinator, Mr. Kiran Dev and the resource persons for the Ashok programmes Mr. Nenmara and Ms. Akshara Devi.



The participants included 17 teachers from various BRCs and 9 IEDC Nodal officers from Technical and Non-technical colleges of Palakkad District.

The remaining one and half days were fully dedicated to impart the idea of Design Thinking to the participants. The trainers, Mr. Ashok Nemmara, Director, Centre for Life Learnings. and Ms. Akshara handled the sessions.

It started with ice breaking and basic design thinking procedures. The participants were grouped into 6 groups and tasks were given to each group. The basic theme was to think like school students when developing the ideas. Whole session lasted till 07.00 pm.

Day 2 (19/01/2023)

Main focus on day 2 was how to engage student groups during the block level YIP. Some tips and tricks to handle the students and make them lively were discussed and some of them were tried by the participants. The programme ended at 05.00 pm.

PALLIATIVE DAY

In the YIP, the issues in the districts are collected and converted into problem statements and handed over to a group of experts called the Community of Practice (CoP) and compiled under the name of Shelf of Problems. This contributes to innovation formation for students participating in YIP.
