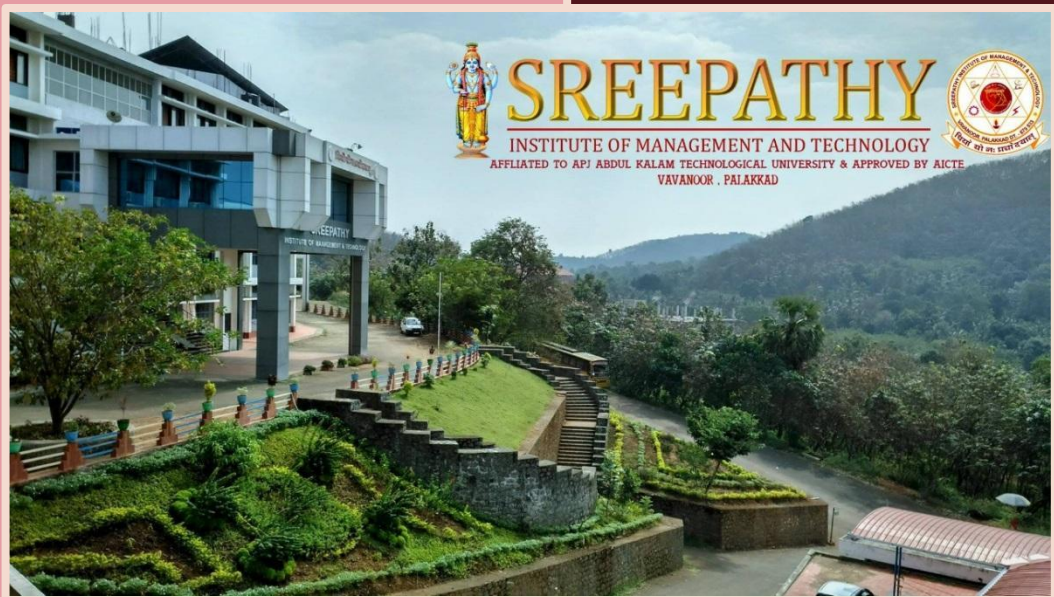

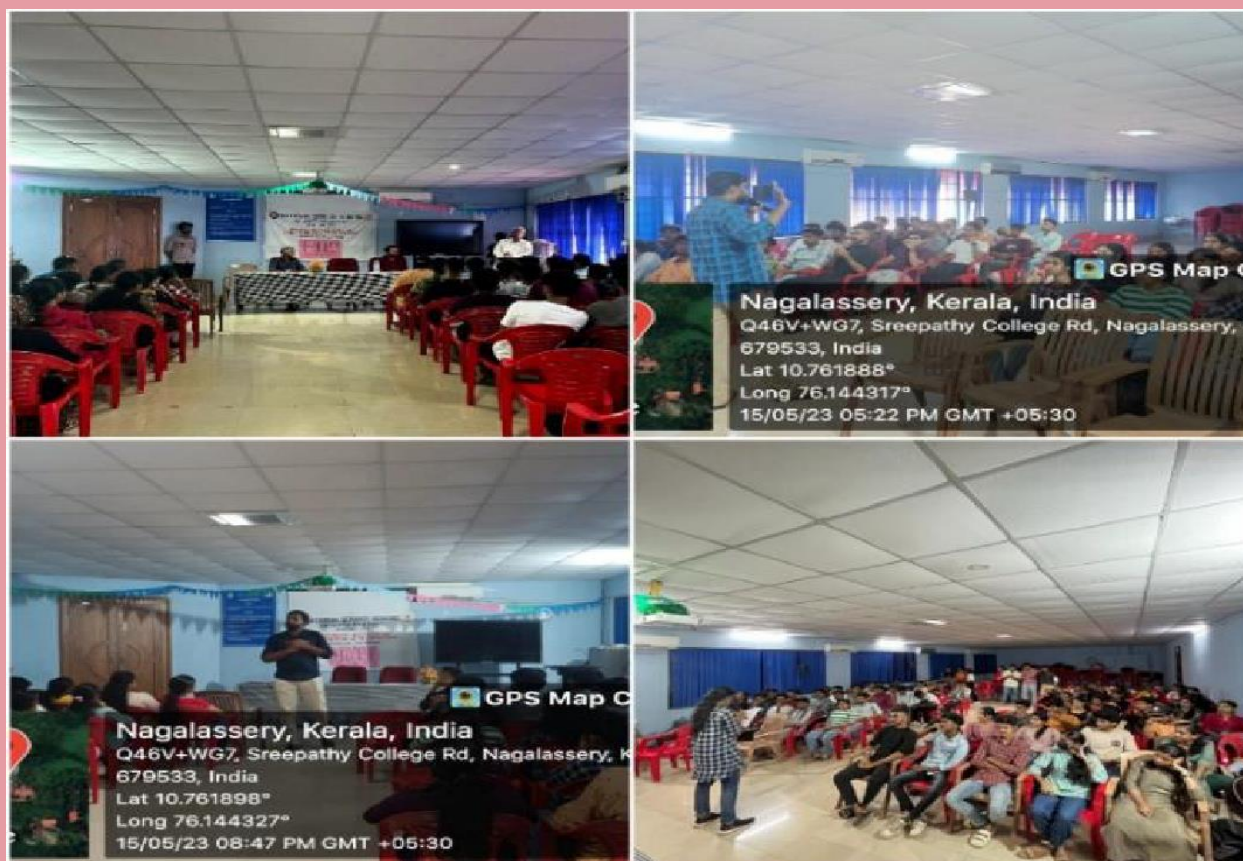

## JWALA ORIENTATION CAMP

## NAAM 2023 – SREEDHAREEYAM BUSINESS MEET

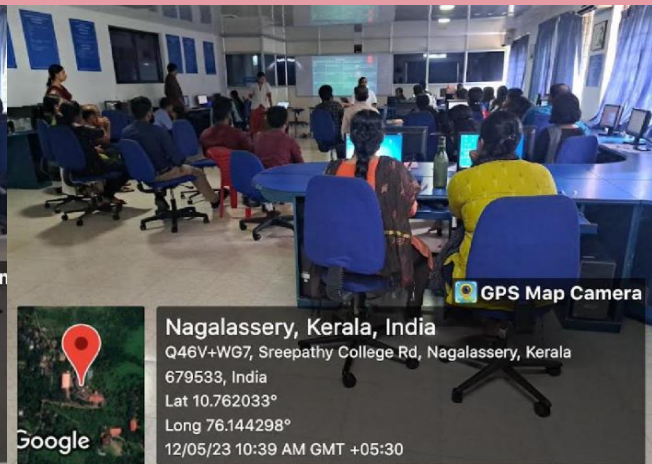
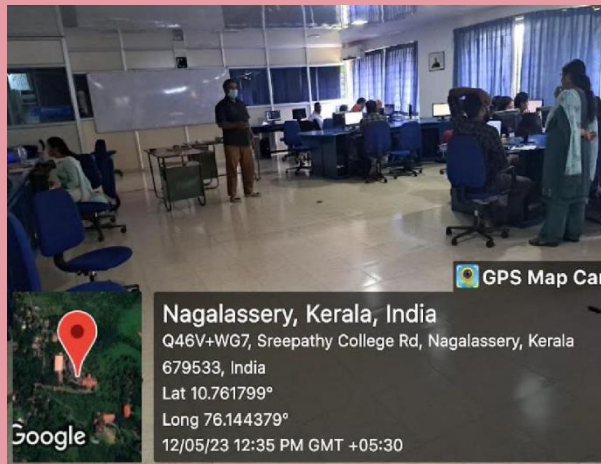
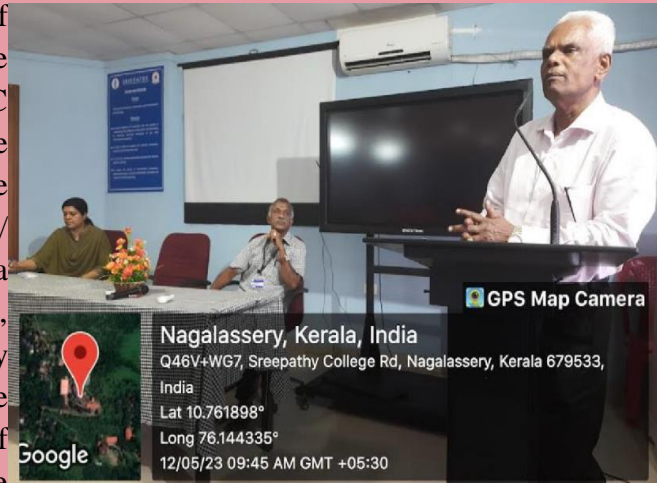

## REPORT ON PROJECT MANAGEMENT SEMINAR

Creative Business Hills, Panthavoor, Changaramkulam, in association with Department of Civil Engineering, Sreepathy Institute of Management and Technology, conducted a half day seminar on the basic concepts of Project management on 08<sup>th</sup> May 2023.

Project Management Seminar was inaugurated by Mr. K Dharmarajan, Rtd. Executive Engineer KSEB. Mr. Sankaranarayanan K M from Sreepathy Institute of Management and Technology and Mr. Irshad from MES Engineering college addressed the gathering.

The programme was conducted at Creative business hills, Panthavoor. Mr. P Manikandan, PM Specialist and author was the presenter. All



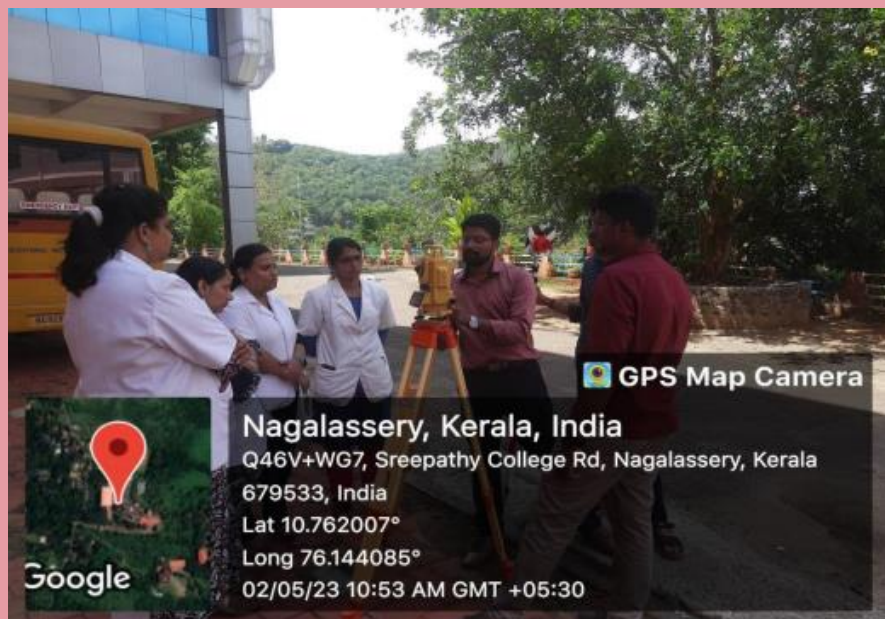
final year students from Sreepathy Institute attended the session. The seminar was organized as two sessions. The first session started at 9.30 am and ended at 11.20 am and the second session was held from the duration of 11.30-1.30 pm. The first session was used for explaining basic theoretical concepts of pm and the second session was conducted as a training session in which a real practical problem solution was explained.



During the first session, the presenter explained the importance of project management concepts and how the concepts are applied in different fields. Basic knowledge areas of project management, project integration management, project scope management, project schedule management etc. were explained in detail. All those who attended the session understood importance and various concepts of project management. This session was briefed on a real practical problem of construction of a building. The presenter explained how to apply the concepts of project schedule management, project procurement management etc. for this problem. Final year students of Sreepathy Institute, students from MES engineering college and working professionals also attended the session.

## TRAINING PROGRAM - TOTAL STATION TRAINING

One-day training on the total station was organized for Civil Engineering faculties on 02<sup>nd</sup> May 2023. The objective of the training is to have an understanding of the various operations that can be done using the total station. The total station is used to measure angles and distances electronically and process trigonometrically to give us, at a minimum, position coordinates in space. The total station available in the surveying laboratory is SOUTH NTS 355 L.



Mr. Geo Paul, Lab instructor, Christ College of Engineering, Irinjalakkuda was the trainer. In the forenoon session, he explained the various functions used in the instrument. In the afternoon session, an area was plotted using the total station. He also demonstrated the same work using another total station (Company: Pentax). The total station can be used to find elevation, prepare contour maps, find out area and volume, and plot an area.

## REPORT - INDUSTRIAL VISIT TO CSIR-NIO

An Industrial Visit and tour programme was arranged for the Fourth Semester Civil, Computer Science, Electronics and Mechanical Engineering students from 30<sup>th</sup> April 2023 to 3<sup>rd</sup> May 2023. 48 second year students and two faculties, Ms. Sreeshma K, AP/CSE & Mr. Crecentine J K, AP/ME accompanied the students.

Principal Dr S P Subramanian inaugurated the event. Students from different departments participated as a team of two members. The programme was a joyous and great event.

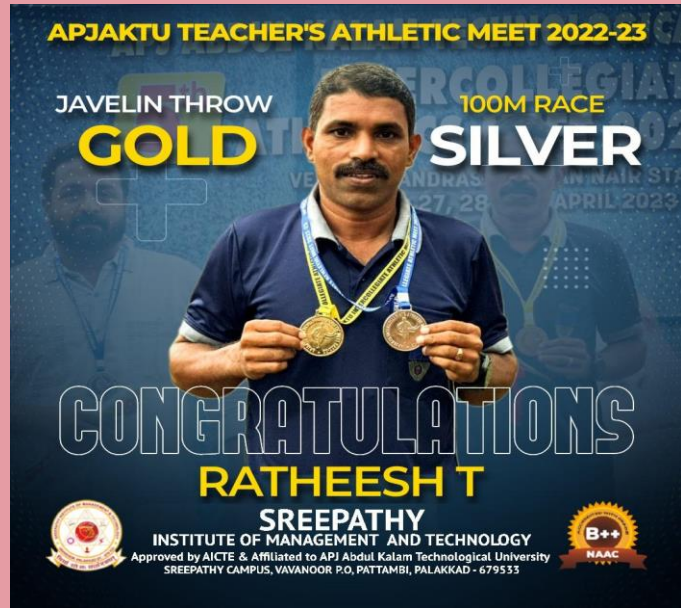
## STUDENT ACHIEVEMENTS
