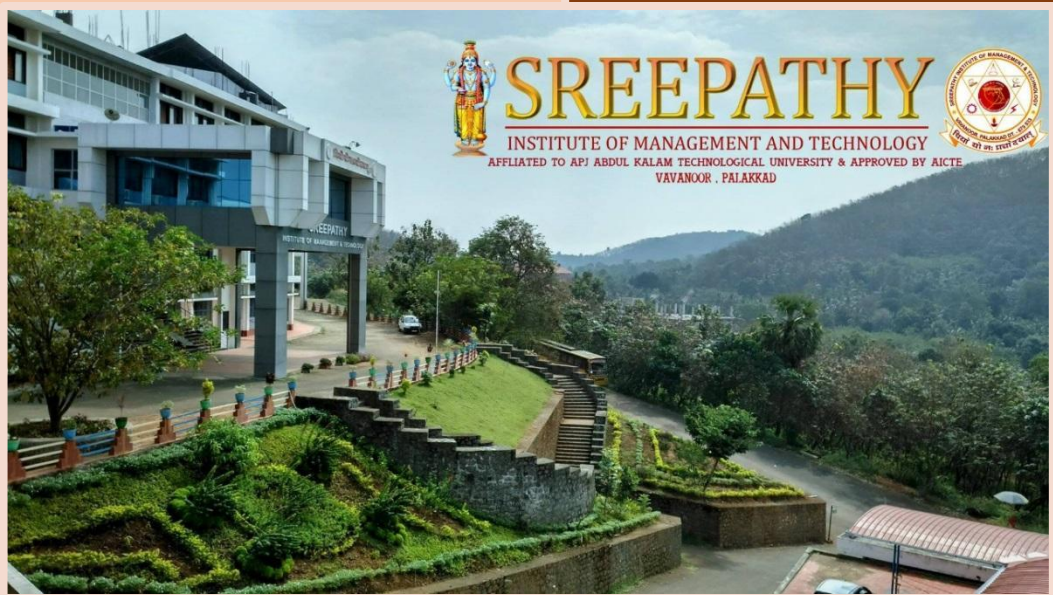

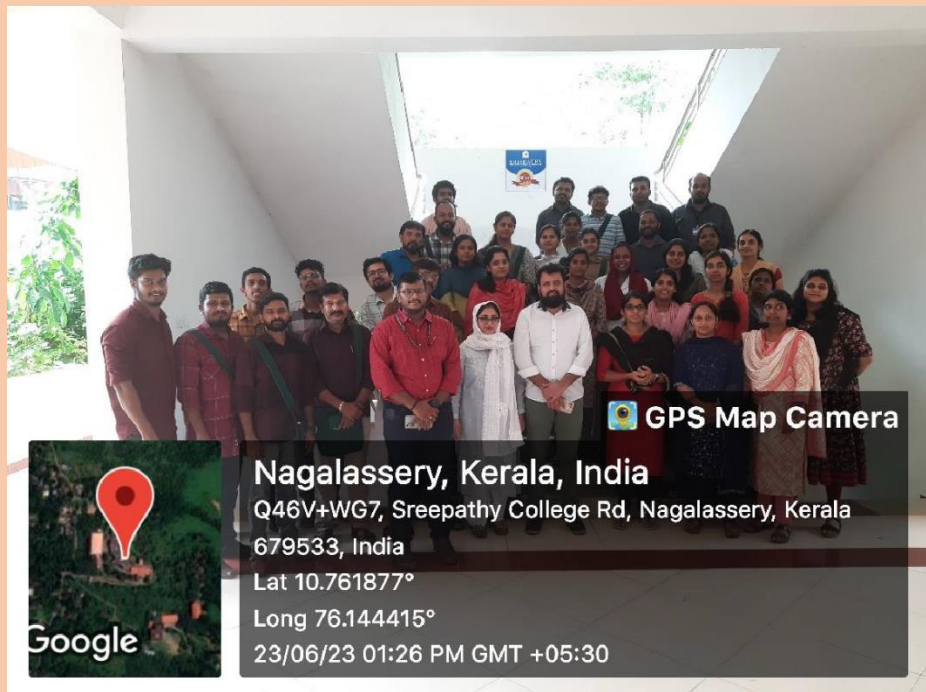

REPORT ON FDP “ENERGY SIMULATION”

A two-day physical training program on "Energy Simulation" for the faculties was conducted at Sreepathy Institute of Management and Technology, Vavannor, on 23rd and 24th June, 2023. As a part of the Energy Efficient Building (EEB) Cell activities for '2022-23' in the State, the EEB Cell at Energy Management Centre (EMC), was conducting a series of awareness Programs on implementation of ECBC and ENS (ECBC-Residential) in the State. This FDP was also a part of that program. The program was conducted at compiler lab with 24 participants.

The program was inaugurated by Dr. S P Subramanian, the Principal of SIMAT. Mr. Saran, Program Officer of EMC, detailed about the importance of the training program. Mr. Abu Talha Farooqi and Ms. Mariyam Zakiah were the ECBC Master Trainers for the program.

Forenoon session was about the importance of Energy Conservation Building Code (ECBC). To improve energy efficiency in the new commercial buildings, Energy Conservation Building Code was created. The Energy Conservation Building Code sets minimum energy standards for new commercial buildings having a connected load of 100



kW or contract demand of 120 kVA or more. The effective implementation of code provides comfort to occupants by adopting passive design strategies & day light Integration. Afternoon

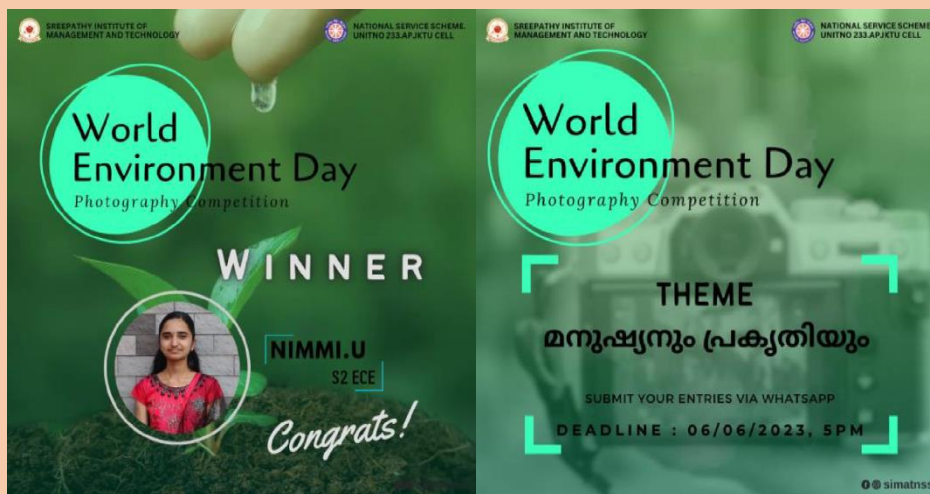


session was an introduction to the software eQUEST. eQUEST allows us to import building geometry from architectural models. It can be used to construct a building envelope within the program. From there simple simulations or very complex models can be created. There are 43 input wizards in eQUEST used to input electrical details, geometry of the building and mechanical systems. The participants were able to input data for the given sample problem containing all the details of a room.

On the second day of the program, an exercise of energy simulation of a building was given to the participants. The participants were able to complete it. The program was only an introduction to the ECBC and energy modeling. Ms. Divya, program officer of EMC explained about the advanced courses offered by EMC with certification in the ECBC and energy simulation. The certificates were distributed by the master trainers at the end of the program. The program came to an end at 4:00 pm

TREE PLANTING

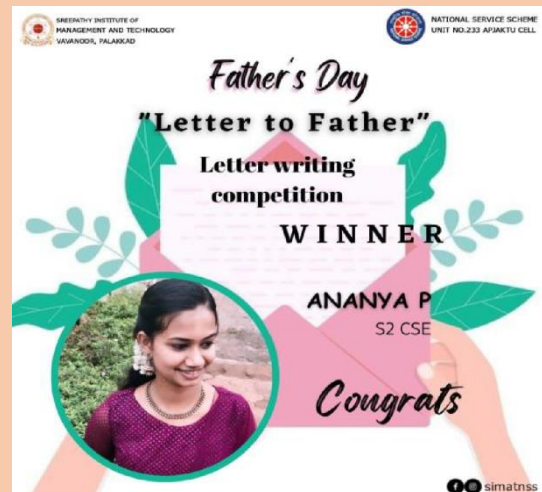

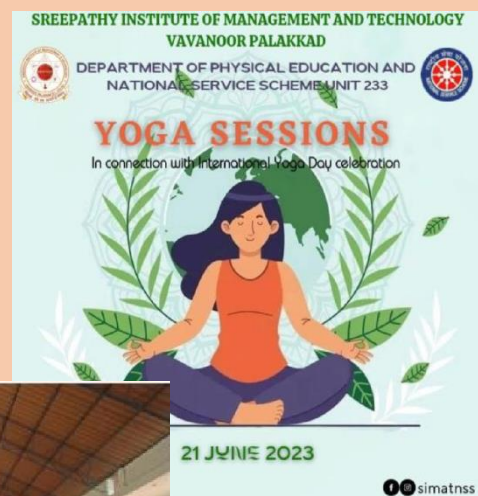
LETTER TO FATHER

FAREWELL 2023

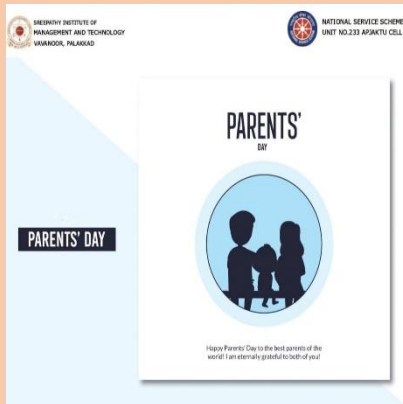
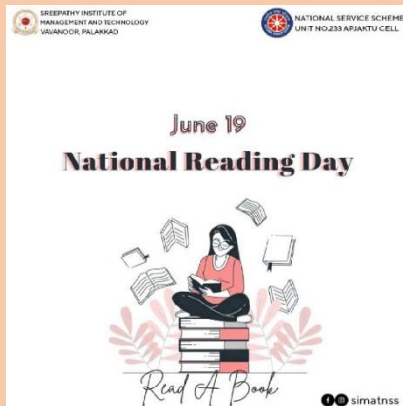

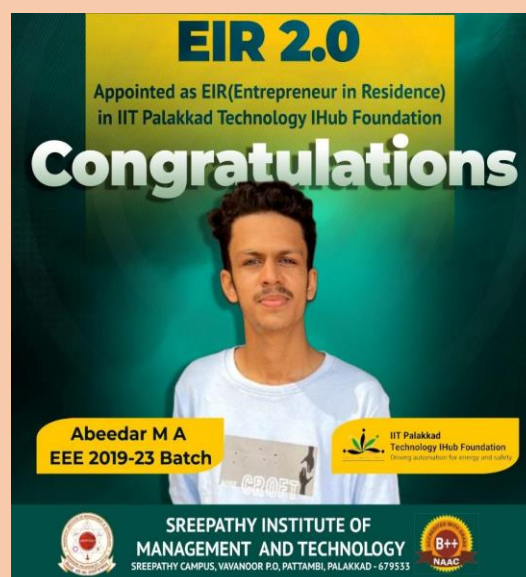


STAFF ACHIEVEMENT
