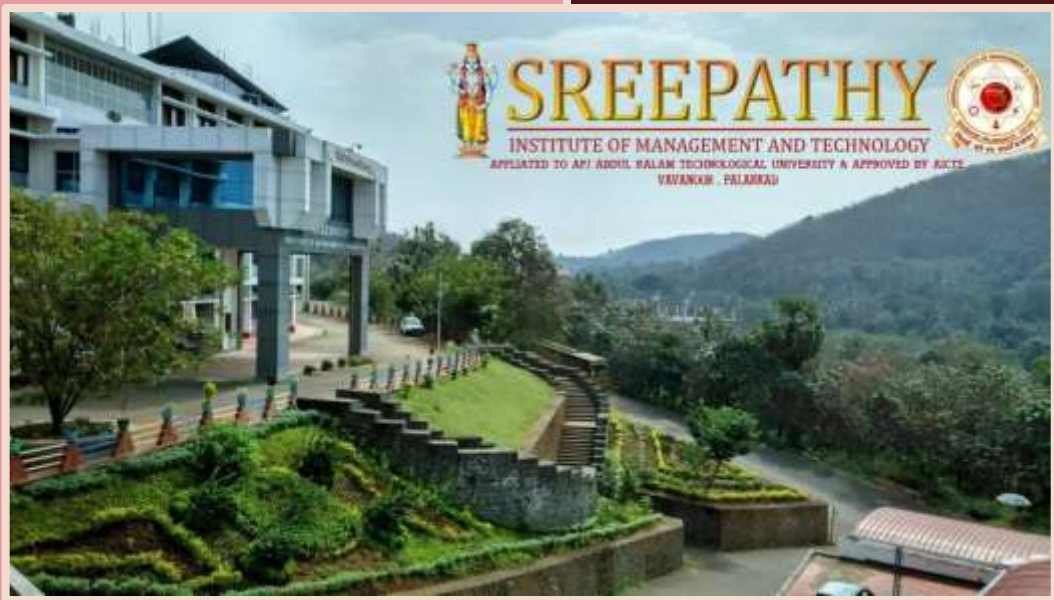

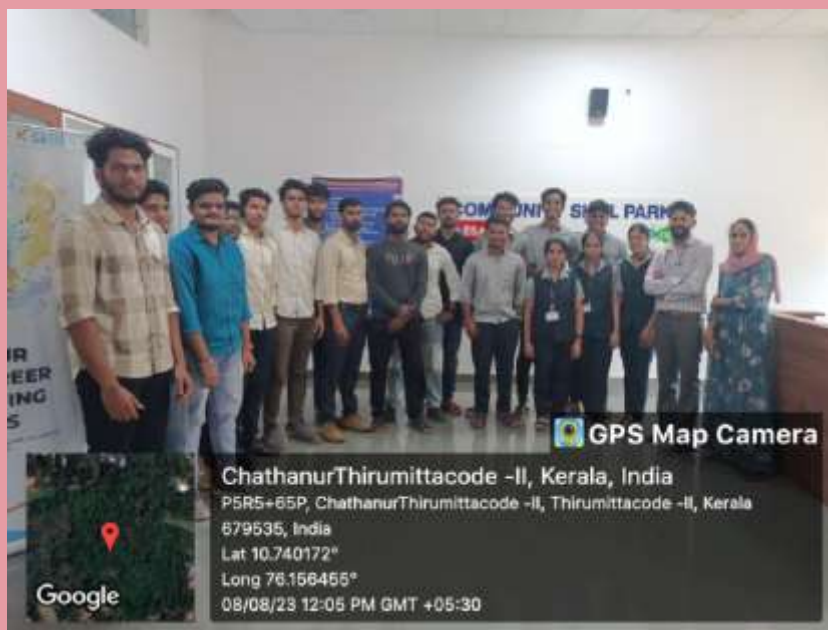
MEMBERSHIP LAUNCH EVENT BY ICT ACADEMY OF KERALA
