

### **INDUCTION PROGRAM 2023**

Induction program, an event that marked the beginning of an exciting journey for our new members was organized during  $4^{th} - 8^{th}$  and on  $20^{th}$  Sep 2023. To make this occasion even more memorable, we have the privilege of hosting a series of special lectures by some of the most distinguished personalities in their respective fields.

The sessions were quite interactive and proved to provide a visualization to distinguish personal, professional, academic and social life with ease and a clear picture of self.

First day of the program started with the impactful session conducted by Mr. Sulfeeker Aly P. K, a renowned educator, life coach, and motivational speaker, who addressed the new students of Sreepathy Engineering College on the topic of "Captainship" Mr. Sulfeeker Aly PK, with his extensive experience in the field of education and personal development, delivered an engaging and insightful talk on the qualities and responsibilities of effective leadership, particularly focusing on the role of a captain.



The second session was introduction to "Training and Placement" by Mr. Janardanan M K, Placement and Training Officer, SIMAT began by providing an overview of the importance of training and placement in the career development of students.

He emphasized how effective training programs can bridge the gap between education and industry requirements. He discussed current trends in the job market and how they influence the training and placement process. This included insights into emerging sectors and the skills in demand. He explained the campus recruitment process and highlighted the role of the Placement and Training Office in facilitating interactions among students. He stressed the importance of skill development and encouraged students to engage in continuous learning to stay competitive in the job market. The event concluded with an interactive Question and Answer session, where students had the opportunity to seek clarification on various topics related to training and placement.



The third session was "GENDER AND SOCIETY" by Dr Smitha Das T V, Principal, Sreepathy Arts and Science College could lay the strong foundation in understanding the dynamics of gender and society as it is essential to embark on this exciting journey of learning and personal growth.

The aim of the session was to analyze the role of gender in society in Interdisciplinary and intersectional gender studies perspectives. She spoke about the current issues related to gender like gender based violence, gender Mainstreaming, sexual harassment, gender bias in education and empowerment.



On second day, the first session was in association with the Excise Department, Thrithala range, Palakkad, SIMAT organized Anti-Drug Awareness Program "DEFEAT DRUGS" by Mr. V. P. Mahesh (Civil Excise Officer & Vimukthi Co-ordinator, Thrithala range). He discussed the

aftereffects that a drug addict has to face in life. He mentioned his experience of handling drug abuse and advised them to cope up with all the persuasions to say "No to drugs".

updated them about various activities taken up as a part and parcel of NSS on second session. He

explained the benefits of a NSS Volunteer and mentioned about acquiring Leadership qualities and democratic attitude.

The third one was the "Ice Breaking and Goal Setting" Session by SIMAT Alumni. Mr. Sreekrishnan, Mr. Sujith, Mr. Sreerag and Mr. Sreeraj explained the importance of setting goals and how it can help them succeed academically and personally. It was aimed to provide valuable



insights into setting and achieving personal and professional goals. To create a friendly and interactive atmosphere, several ice-breaking activities were conducted at the beginning of the event. 
