


Conclusion

RED HAT CERTIFIED SYSTEM ADMINISTRATOR COURSE

The Red Hat Certified System Administrator (RHCSA) course was recently started by Sreepathy Institute of Management and Technology, Vavanoor in collaboration with Vidya Training and Development Center (VTDC), Thrissur. The program aimed to contribute to the professional development and academic excellence of the students. The 72 hours of training includes the basics of RedHat Linux, managing users and groups, control services, managing networks, file systems, command-line productivity, storage stack, boot process, and network security.

15 students from the sixth semester Computer Science and Engineering department (2021 batch) were enrolled for the RHCSA program. The classes for the RHCSA program commenced on 04-11-2023 and it was successfully completed on 06-04-2024. As per the terms, the students have paid a course fee of Rs. 8500/- and exam fee of Rs. 11000/-. The final exam was conducted on 13-05-2024 at SIMAT, Vavanoor. 11 out of the 15 students (73%) passed the exam. A second chance without any fee has been provided to the four students. Two students passed in the second chance, one failed and one still pending to take the second attempt. The students who successfully completed the course obtained the RHCSA certificates.

The RHCSA program is a good choice to gain more foundational knowledge of Linux and its components since these skills are transferable to various roles. The skills acquired through this program align with the industry's demands, thus making our students more competitive in the job market.

KEAM CBT 2024

Kerala Engineering Architecture and Medical (KEAM) Examination is organized and conducted

every year by CEE Kerala. Unlike previous years, in 2024, the examination was conducted as a Computer Based Online Test. Sreepathy was an identified test venue (Venue no:170) coming under Palakkad District. The test was conducted during 5th to 9th June 2024 with trial and mock

tests on 24th, 25th May 2024 and on 03rd June 2024. Also the Pharmacy test was held on 10th June 2024.

The systems allotted in Sreepathy was 140 including a 10% buffer. In all, 520 candidates attended the test in Sreepathy during these days. The entire Sreepathy
