Day 1: 02/07/2024

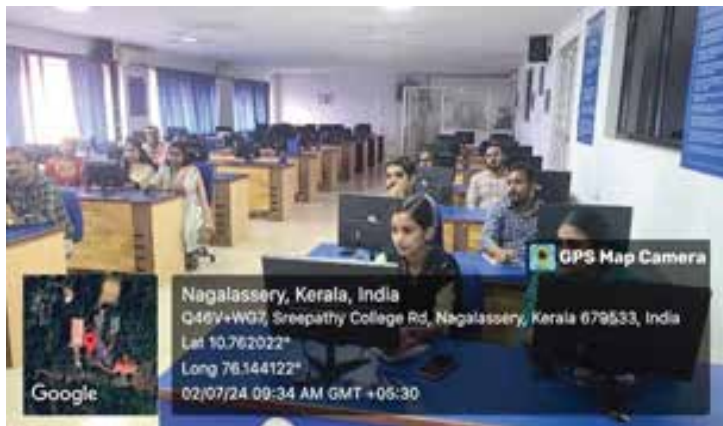

Day 3: 05/07/2024

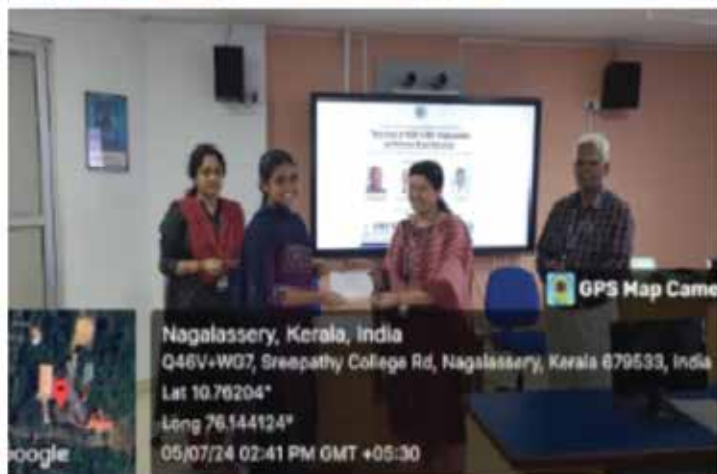

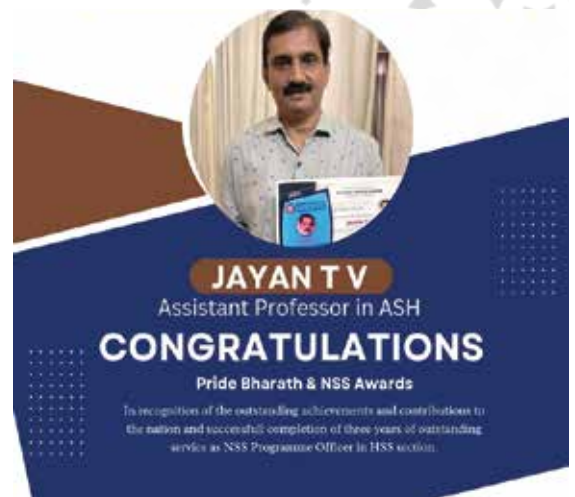
2. Mr. Jayan T V is nominated as NSS P.O. with effect from 17.07.2024.

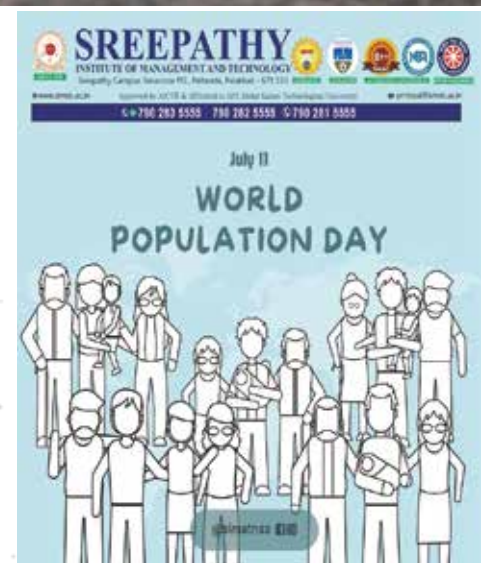
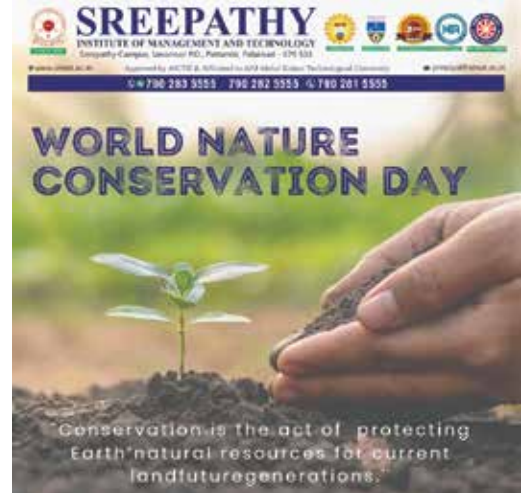
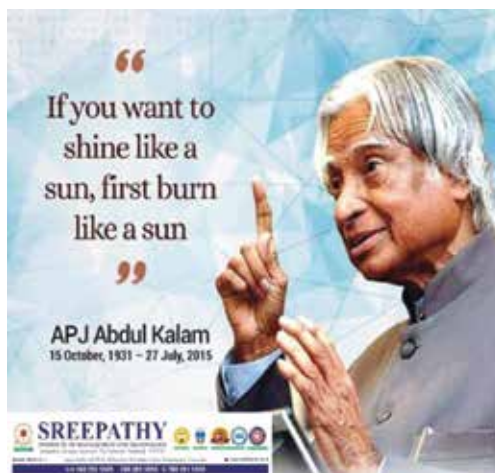
