THE RHCSA COURSE

The RHCSA course, conducted in collaboration with Vidya Training Development Center and (VTDC), Thrissur, concluded successfully at Sreepathy Institute. Spanning from November 2023 to April 2024, the 72-hour course was attended by students from the 2021 batch of the Computer Science and Engineering department. The course fee was ₹8,500, and the exam fee was ₹11,000.


Out of the 15 students, 11 successfully cleared the certification on their first attempt, achieving a 73% success rate. A complimentary second attempt enabled two additional students to clear the certification. The RHCSA course equipped students with critical industry-relevant skills, enhancing their career prospects.

S8 RESULTS

The S8 examination results for the 2020 batch at Sreepathy Institute of Management and Technology were announced, revealing an impressive overall pass percentage of 85.88%. The Civil Engineering department achieved a remarkable 100% pass rate, with Sivani Sivan C.K., Medha Vasudevan M., and Aswathy P. emerging as toppers. In the Computer Science and Engineering department, the pass percentage was 88%, led by toppers Ayisha Pareekkutty, Kavya Haridas, and Aiswarya R.

The Electronics and Communication Engineering department reported a pass rate of 76.82%, with Anjali K., Rushidha Nasrin K., and Navya Das securing the top positions. The Electrical and Electronics Engineering department achieved an 80% pass rate, with Vimal K. N., Gayathri Suresh, and Abhinand E. leading the charts. The Mechanical Engineering department had a pass rate of 71.4%, with Jino Babu E., Sooraj K. P., and Pranav C. N. as toppers.

These results underscore the commitment of the students and faculty to academic excellence.



EXPERT TALK




REPUBLIC DAY CELEBRATION
